

# Spring Maintenance Checklist

Staying pro-active with your car care routine may help save you from trouble down the road – especially after harsh winter weather. Tune up with these tips for Spring vehicle maintenance.

## 1 – 3 Years Old

- Oil/filter – change at the manufacturer's recommended intervals
- Check tire pressure & tread depth
- Examine wiper blades for excessive wear and replace if necessary
- Check all fluid levels and refill as needed
- Clean interior
- Remove snow tires if applicable
- Check radiator and gas caps

## 3 – 5 Years Old

- Test battery
- Get brakes examined
- Oil/filter – change at the manufacturer's recommended intervals
- Check tire pressure & tread depth
- Examine wiper blades for excessive wear and replace if necessary
- Check all fluid levels and refill as needed
- Clean interior
- Remove snow tires if applicable
- Check radiator and gas caps

## 6+ Years Old

- Test battery
- Get brakes examined
- Oil/filter – change at the manufacturer's recommended intervals
- Check tire pressure & tread depth
- Examine wiper blades for excessive wear and replace if necessary
- Refill wiper fluid
- Check all fluid levels and refill as needed
- Clean interior
- Remove snow tires if applicable
- Check radiator and gas caps
- Check spark plugs
- Check cabin air filter
